Long Creek RV Park Rules

- 1. Our quiet hours are 10:00 pm to 7:00 am in your RV as well as the campground.
- Speed limit is 10 mph--NO EXCEPTIONS. Be sure to look out for kids because they're surely not looking out for you.
- Campers are responsible for the safety and actions of their children and/or guests. Children under age 9 must be with an adult at all times.
- 4. Please keep your campsite clean. No outside garbage cans. Place your garbage in our dumpsters located near the grey shed. Household trash only. Do not dispose of old grills, chairs, umbrellas, tents, etc. in or near the dumpsters.
- Only boats owned by registered campers are allowed to launch at the park. No guest boats are allowed to launch without permission. NOTE: The fishing dock and all piers may be slippery.
- 6. PET POLICY: We do not allow any large, aggressive breeds or nuisance dogs. No pet can be a nuisance to any of our guests at any time. For example, excessive barking (even by a small dog) is a problem for other folks camping near you. Pets must be on a leash with an adult when outside and cannot be left unattended on any type of tie-out device, dog crate, or portable fencing. Dogs should not be left unattended in campers. Rain or shine--always be sure to scoop the poop!
- 7. Our pet policy is in place in order to provide a peaceful, quiet, and safe environment for all our guests. For safety reasons, when walking your dog, please avoid direct contact with any other dog owners or their pets. Do not walk your dog on the piers as it presents a trip hazard and the possibility of any number of other issues. Please remember: You may know your dog is friendly, but others do not.
- 8. We reserve the right to ask any guest to leave based on the behavior of your pet.
- 9. No fencing is to be put on any lot.
- 10. Please report all outside leaking or broken pipes as soon as possible.
- 11. Must be 18 years old to use the camp owned canoe. ALL WATER CRAFT ARE LAUNCHED AT YOUR OWN RISK.
- 12. WATER LEVEL AT THE PIER IS ONLY 2-3 FEET AT ALL TIMES. DIVING OR JUMPING FROM

THE PIER COULD BE EXTREMELY DANGEROUS.

- No washing of dishes or cooking utensils in the clubhouse. Do not leave items in bathrooms or on the porch. No pets are allowed in the clubhouse.
- 14. No decks or outside sheds may be constructed, do not stake shelters in the ground unless authorized.
- 15. Loud music within the campground is prohibited.
- 16. No bicycle riding after dusk. No riding over the bridge or on the pier. Children under age 13 not permitted on the pier without an adult.
- 17. Campfires are allowed in covered fire pits only and may not be left unattended. No ground campfires.
- 18. As a family, friendly campground, Long Creek RV Park is committed to providing a wholesome atmosphere for children and adults alike. Alcoholic beverages are allowed to be consumed discreetly at your campsite and must not be in open display.
- 19. No obnoxious or offensive activity shall be allowed in any area of the campground.
- 20. We reserve the right to discharge any campers and/or guests not abiding by park rules.
- 21. Watch out for rip/rap stones, roots and branches at water's edge and in park. Shoes should be worn on pier, clubhouse, and porch.
- 22. Fireworks and illegal firearms are prohibited.
- Suspected criminal activity including misdemeanors will not be tolerated, and is grounds for immediate eviction. This applies to minors and adult residents.
- 24. No golf carts, UTVs, ATVs are allowed in the park.
- 25. All site rentals, including tents and campers, are considered as Temporary Vacation Rentals, and as such shall be governed by the N.C. General Statutes that apply to such temporary vacation site agreements—i.e., the campground owners, staff, or managers may instruct any camper, their guests, or camper or RV owner to remove themselves and/or their property from the campground for any reason whatsoever. Once the request is made by the owners, staff, or management, the Sheriff may be contacted to insure compliance with the request.
- 26. Rates are based on double occupancy only.
